JOB DESCRIPTION
Worship Leader – Mount Pleasant / Scottdale
(Support Staff – Part Time)

The role of the Worship Leader serves under the direction of the Campus Pastor to select music, rehearse the campus music team, and lead the campus in musical and prayerful worship on Sunday mornings.

The Worship Leader is responsible for:

1. Modeling Biblical Priorities

Upholding Biblical priorities and the staff core values. The Worship Leader should represent a growing personal relationship with Jesus. The Worship Leader models a strong relationship with his or her spouse (if married) and children (if applicable). The Worship Leader strives to fulfill his or her purpose in life and ministry while demonstrating integrity in words, relationships, and actions. These objectives are accomplished by:

- Committing to daily prayer, Bible study, and weekly corporate worship.
- Participating in a small group on a regular basis.
- Being a disciple maker by investing and loving unchurched neighbors.
- Giving generously to the work of God at Charter Oak Church.
- Joining a team that seeks to alleviate poverty locally, nationally, or internationally.
- Setting appropriate boundaries to protect character and integrity.
- Adhering to and encompassing the qualities and characteristics required of Charter Oak Church employees, as defined by the Staff Handbook.

2. Hands On Responsibilities

Is responsible to ensure the following tasks are completed:

- Rehearsing music in advance of rehearsals and worship services.
- Selecting music, organizing, and rehearsing with the worship team, and leading the campus congregation in musical/prayerful worship.
- Working closely with the Campus Pastor for scheduling and service details related to music.
- Recruiting, training, and discipling members of the worship team.
- Developing relationships with worship team members and encouraging the teams spiritual and emotional growth through team sharing, prayer, and/or Bible study, and outside activities.
- Being on time to all commitments.
- Raising up and apprenticing new worship leaders.
- Planning worship services in coordination with the Campus Pastor.
